Students who are enrolled in our partner universities, and were nominated by the home institution.

Students whose G.P.A. is 2.5/4.0 or higher [Partner University], 3.0/4.0 or higher [ISEP/UMAP].

Students who have a Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) score of N3 or higher or the equivalent of CEFR B2 or higher in English or who come from a university where the language of instruction is Japanese or English.


