
- (1) Advice about all aspects of student life

Student Exchange Program

Student Exchange Program at Kanagawa University

Exchange students at Kanagawa University (KU) each belong to a department or graduate school, and they study Japanese language subjects, subjects related to Japan, and subjects in their study field.

Period of Student Exchange

Our exchange program starts in April (1st semester) and Sept. (2nd semester) every year. Students may start the program in April or Sept. for one semester or two. Most of the classes run for a semester only, but some classes start in April and run for two semesters. Please ask for any details.

Eligibility

In order to apply for the Exchange Program, students must:

- (1) be a student at one of the partner institutions of Kanagawa University and recommended by it;
- (2) have the language ability equivalent to N2 (or Level 2 in former system) or above of Japanese Language Proficiency Test. * Even if students do not have Japanese language ability equivalent to N2 or above, we might accept their applications if they have enough English proficiency for taking courses in their study area. Student Accommodation

KU has student accommodation for exchange students. Yokohama campus has student accommodation (costs ¥35,000/month, including utility bills). These are located within 5 minute walk from the campus. Shonan Hiratsuka Campus has Students Apartments for female and male students KU can arrange homestay according to the request.

Scholarship for Exchange Students

KU offers the "YONEDA Yoshimori Education Scholarship (for Exchange Students)" scholarships, with a monthly stipend of 50,000 yen, for all exchange students from partner institutions. Exchange students might instead be allocated the scholarship called "Student Exchange Support Program (Scholarship for Short-Term Study in Japan)" from Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO), with a monthly stipend of 80,000 yen, if we receive the funding and they meet the requirements placed on recipients by JASSO regarding grades and economic situation.
